# Procedures from Application to Admission

1	Send necessary documents and application fee	Submit application documents before deadline
2	Examination by school	After the documents are received, the decision or admission is made by document review and selection. After receiving application documents, we judge admission to school by examining documents and selection.  Admission certificates will be provided, and application documents will file to Immigration Bureau for permission of stay.
3	Examination by Immigration Bureau suance of Certificate of Eligibility	"Certificates of eligibility" will be issued by Immigration Bureau.
4	Payment of tuition fee School send you Letter of Acceptance and Certificate of Eligibility	School notify the applicant after the issue of Certification of Eligibility by Immigration bureau. Make payment of the entrance fee, tuition fee, facility fee, activity charge, etc. to the bank account of school. Afte confirming receiving money, school send the applicant Certificate of eligibility, Letter of Acceptance, Schedule of admission.

### Refund policies Tuition Refund Policy

#### (Based on the guidelines of the Association for the Promotion of Japanese Language Education)

①In the case that a Certificate of Eligibility has been issued but you did not apply for a visa and did not come to Japan

Conditions: Retarn the admission letter and Certificate of Eligibility

Refund: Refund of all payments except the entrance fee.

②If you are unable to come to Japan because your application for a visa has not been approved by the Japanese embassy

Conditions: Return the admission letter and submit proof that your visa has not been issued at the Japanese embassy.

Refund: Refund all payments except the entrance fee.

③If you have a visa, but decline to enroll before coming to Japan.

Conditions: Return of the admission letter and confirmation that the visa has not been used and has expired.

Refund: Refund all payments except the entrance fee.

④ When the student who has obtained a visa and enrolled in Japan withdraws from the school without a valid reason.

Refund: As a general rule, we don't refund full payment deposits.

⑤ If you are not admitted after arriving in Japan

Refund : we don't refund full payment deposits

- The application fee is not refundable for any reasons.
- The remittance fee is to be paid by the applicant.

Dormitories are available for single, double or triple occupancy, with rent depending on the type of room. Single room cost 35,000 yen per month, double room 30,000 yen and triple room 25,000 yen. Kitchen, toilet and bathroom are shared and to pay one's own expense. Dormitory fee are payable every six months by bank transfer.
